

Doctoral Student in European and Global Governance (E13 TV-L, max. 75%)

The **Hochschule für Politik (HfP) / TUM School of Governance (GOV)** focuses on future-oriented, transdisciplinary, and applied research and teaching. The **Chair of European and Global Governance** is looking for a doctoral student. The successful candidate will be engaged in the following tasks and have the qualifications specified below. The doctoral candidate is encouraged to spend a significant part of his/her studies abroad at the home institute of the TUM-IAS Fellow at the University of Sydney in Australia.

Tasks:

- Research and teaching in Global Economic Governance, with a focus on China
- Teaching and supervising graduate and undergraduate students at HfP/GOV
- Interdisciplinary research at the intersection between Politics and Technology, which includes joint publications with the chair holder and the IAS fellow Prof. Susan Park
- Support of the chair on administrative, research, and teaching related issues

Qualifications:

- Outstanding graduate degree in Political Science, International Relations, or International Political Economy
- Expertise in International Organizations, Global Economic Governance, and/or China
- Excellent academic record
- Training and expertise in quantitative and/or qualitative methods
- Ability to work in an international team
- English language proficiency and also ideally fluent in Mandarin

Salary will be paid according to remuneration level 13 of the wage agreement for public service in the federal states (TV-L13). The post is **part-time** on a fixed term contract for **3 years**. Applicants with disabilities will be given preferential treatment if qualifications are by and large equal. The HfP/GOV seeks to increase the number of women in areas in which they are underrepresented. Therefore, we particularly encourage qualified women to apply. The HfP/GOV further aims to hire more people with disabilities and encourages them to apply.
