

## Post-Doctoral Researcher and Lecturer in European and Global Governance (E13 TV-L)

The **Chair of European and Global Governance** is looking for a post-doctoral researcher and lecturer. The successful candidate will be engaged in the following tasks and have the qualifications specified below.

### Tasks:

- Research and teaching in European and Global Governance, with a focus on International Organizations, Global Governance in the Digital Age, and Qualitative Methods
- Teaching and supervising graduate and undergraduate students at HfP/GOV
- Interdisciplinary research at the intersection between Politics and Technology, which includes joint publications with the chair holder and the preparation of grant applications at the national and European levels
- Support of the chair on administrative, research, and teaching related issues

### Qualifications:

- Outstanding doctoral degree in Political Science or Economics
- Excellent academic record with relevant high-level publications
- Academic advising and teaching experience
- Training and expertise in quantitative and/or qualitative methods
- Ability to work in an international team
- English language proficiency
- Sufficient language skills in German for independent teaching
- Successful record in third-party funding acquisition is an asset

Salary will be paid according to remuneration level 13 of the wage agreement for public service in the federal states (TV-L13). The post is **full-time** on a fixed term contract for **3 years** (with the possibility of prolongation). Applicants with disabilities will be given preferential treatment if qualifications are by and large equal. The HfP/GOV seeks to increase the number of women in areas in which they are underrepresented. Therefore, we particularly encourage qualified women to apply. The HfP/GOV further aims to hire more people with disabilities and encourages them to apply.
