Democratic Governance and Transgovernmental Networks

Sandra Lavenex is Professor of European and international politics at the University of Geneva and Vice-Dean of the School of Social Sciences. She is also Visiting Professor at the College of Europe. Her fields of research include European and international migration policy, European Union external relations and the EU's role in global governance, and democratic governance beyond the state. She is member of the Swiss National Center for Competence in Research NCCR "on the move" and was project and module leader in the Swiss National Center for Competence in Research NCCR "Challenges to Democracy in the 21st Century" (2005-2017).
